Attachment to Articles of Incorporation Nonprofit Corporation -- Domestic Ligamina Inc.

Additional provisions Ligamina Inc. elects to include in its Articles of Incorporation:

8(a) The specific purposes of this corporation shall be to finance and otherwise facilitate the reconstruction, restoration and rehabilitation of works of art, including, but not limited to, structures and other works of architecture, paintings, and sculpture, expected to be or thencurrently on display or otherwise accessible to the general public that are owned by charitable or religious organizations or the Italian government or its local subdivisions. Subject to Section 8(b)(ii) of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall be permitted to conduct other lawful activities permitted under the South Carolina Nonprofit Corporation Act of 1994.

8(b) (i) This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

(ii) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

(iii) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

8(c) The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net earnings or assets of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of (or be distributable to) any director or officer of this corporation or other private person, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its charitable purposes.
